Emmanuel Clinic
Port-au-Prince, Haiti



In 2003 Randolph World Ministries, Inc. established a relationship with Mac Burberry, one of the American directors of Haitian Christian Outreach (HCO). HCO had built a school and church in Port called Emmanuel. They had also just acquired an American Physician Assistant, Teresa Murphy who had been a full-time missionary practicing in a clinic in Seguin for the previous two years. HCO was planning to build a nice, large clinic in Port adjacent to the Emmanuel. Randolph World Ministries, Inc. provided HCO with 12 boxes of medical supplies and a promise to service their new clinic lab once it was completed. In 2007, I was able to fly from Cap to Port and service the nearly finished Emmanuel Clinic (upper left panel). I assisted in drawing the interior plans regarding the placement of cabinets, shelving, plumbing, and counter tops. I also performed three days of training for two future employees and for Teresa Murphy who came to Port from Seguin for the training. The clinic is slated to open for business around Thanksgiving

of 2007. The other three panels shows medical mission clinics held on the school grounds while the clinic was under construction.
